

TVVL Student Competition Submission Guidelines

Before you submit:

Please read the competition instructions (announced by REHVA) very carefully. Your submission should comply with the rules of REHVA Student Competition.

If you wish to compete, please submit one A4 page with an abstract of your thesis ending with a short paragraph explaining why you think your research can be nominated.

An appropriate thesis abstract for this submission is of maximum 1 page length. Please avoid tricks to fit your description into this limit. It is very important to stick to the rules from the very beginning!

Your text includes a few lines of introduction to the topic, explaining the importance of the area of research in the real life. Explain then the scientific and social relevance of the work you are delivering. Thereafter, explain the scientific gap and what main question your research answers at the end. Continue with explaining the method(s) you have used in your work. Thereafter, mention the most important results very briefly and write a very short main conclusion of your thesis in one or two sentences which should reflect on the answer to your research question.
